

EIS is one of the few schools in Vietnam to offer a continuum of three programmes from the International Baccalaureate (IB) curriculum:



Middle Years Programme (MYP) from Grade 6 to Grade 10 (from 11 to 15 years of age)

Diploma Programme (DP)

Grade 11 and Grade 12 (from 16 to 18 years of age)

The IB pathway is different from alternative programmes. Our students acquire the skills and embrace the values of the IB Learner Profile within an inquiry-based learning environment, enabling a smooth transition to other schools and universities around the globe.

We are one of a select group of international schools that are accredited by the Council of International Schools (CIS). This external accreditation is testament to EIS adhering to the highest international quality standards in school operations.

OUR FACILITIES

Our garden-centred campus, features 12 villas, 2 purpose-built facilities, 2 tennis courts, 3 state of the art science laboratories, an innovative design space, and a multi-purpose room. Sports facilities include a 25 metre swimming pool, 2 football fields, 2 tennis courts and 3 multi-use sports courts.

EIS provides a safe, secure and nurturing environment for students to learn, grow and develop. We aim for our school to serve as an extension of a family's values and vision.

Our sports facilities make leisure and physical education enjoyable at EIS. As part of the PE syllabus, our students learn essential skills such as swimming techniques, fitness options, teamwork and cooperation.

Early Years

Early Years Programme: Toddler Class to Preschool

Our Early Years educators implement the International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme (PYP) in combination with the Reggio Emilia philosophy.

Our Early Years classes cater for children aged 2 to 5. We encourage our youngest learners to become independent and help them understand how to transfer their skills when they experience different environments. They learn to apply their knowledge in school, at home, and in the outside world. By helping Early Years students to see that learning is connected to everything they do in life, a solid foundation for lifelong learning is established.

Early Years lessons are child-centred, engaging and allow students to demonstrate their agency by providing them with exciting opportunities to express their opinions and needs while helping them make sensible choices. This guidance encourages them to take ownership of their learning and enjoy their first introduction to school. Children use their imagination and curiosity to explore, learn and develop through play, experimentation, and inquiry. Our Early Years teachers support this natural inclination with an individualised learning model.





Primary School

Primary Years Programme (Grades 1 to 5)

The International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme (PYP) is the curriculum framework applied throughout the Primary School.

Our Primary School learners (aged 6 - 11) build upon the foundations established in the Early Years. Our dedicated Primary teachers strive to maintain the joy of learning while implementing our engaging, academically demanding, and complex Primary Years curriculum. We believe that all children have a natural thirst for knowledge and are eager to learn in a conducive environment. Therefore, every child in our school receives an inspiring Primary education that suits their personality, interests, and future goals.

A wide variety of extra-curricular activities are also available for students to enjoy. With a broad selection of athletic, cultural, and artistic activities, our Primary Years students can hone their abilities, learn new skills, and make new friends in a relaxed and fun atmosphere.

Middle School

Middle Years Programme (Grades 6 to 10)

The IB Middle Years Programme (MYP) encourages students aged 11 to 15 to explore the connections between academic subjects and the real world through experiential learning projects that build critical-thinking skills.

The IB MYP Programme at EIS instils a positive attitude toward learning by challenging students to solve problems and show creativity and resourcefulness while encouraging them to participate in their communities.

Aspects of this curriculum reflect real life by providing a framework that allows students to see the connections in their learning and how their knowledge may be applied to real-life situations. Learning is, therefore, relevant and allows the MYP students to appreciate the content of their lessons.

In the Middle Years Programme, there is an emphasis on using Approaches to Learning (ATLs), which are designed to encourage and improve communication, self-management and social skills, as well as developing critical and creative thinking abilities and research skills.

While English is the language of instruction, all MYP students study at least one other language. MYP students can choose from Vietnamese, Korean, German, Spanish and French language courses. There is also an option for students to study their mother tongue.





High School

Diploma Programme (Grades 11 to 12)

The IB Diploma Programme, designed for students in Grades 11 and 12, is a pre-university qualification that is recognised in more than 140 countries. The IBDP is an academically challenging and balanced programme of education that prepares students for success at university and life beyond graduation. The IBDP curriculum emphasises students' intellectual, social, emotional, and physical well-being, while encouraging their participation in a rapidly evolving and increasingly global society.

Students select subjects from six subject groups, which provides a depth of knowledge and understanding across multiple disciplines. IBDP students are encouraged to develop good study skills and a positive attitude toward learning that will prepare them for higher education.

IBDP students make connections across traditional academic disciplines and explore the nature of knowledge through the programme's unique Theory of Knowledge (TOK) course. IBDP students also undertake an in-depth research project with the Extended Essay (EE). To excel in both TOK and the EE students use critical thinking and research skills while exploring particular topics. The IB Diploma Programme also offers personal, social, and interpersonal development through Creativity, Activity, and Service (CAS) module.

European International School Ho Chi Minh City (EIS) is one of a few IB World Schools in Vietnam to offer the Continuum IB Programmes - the Primary Years Programme (PYP), the Middle Years Programme (MYP), and the Diploma Programme (DP). Since 2014, the school has offered scholarships to students who show academic promise. This year, EIS continues to offer scholarship opportunities to students who have demonstrate exceptional academic performance and a commitment to community service. Merit- based scholarships are available for new students entering Grade 10 or Grade 11 who have the potential to achieve high IB Diploma scores.

Sports & Athletics

As one of the central pillars of an Inspired education, an engaging and challenging sports and athletics programme is at the core of a holistic learning experience. Participation in a sports programme allows students to learn about healthy lifestyles, make friends, and develop necessary life skills, such as perseverance, collaboration, teamwork, critical thinking, leadership, and ethics. Mastering a sport also gives learners confidence in the above areas, which emanates into other areas of their lives.

Over 30 teams represent EIS each year in SISAC (Saigon International School Athletic Conference) competitions. EIS Orcas compete in Soccer, Volleyball, Swimming, Basketball, Badminton, Track and Field, and Cross-Country competitions from the U11 level up to U19 level. When travel permits, our teams travel internationally to compete against schools from other countries.

Performing & Visual Arts

As part of the international, holistic education we offer at EIS, we celebrate the arts, not only through the creation of images and objects, but also in the way we appreciate, enjoy, respect and respond to the practices of artmaking by others from around the world. As one of the three pillars of education at our School, along with academics and sports, we aim to ensure all students have the opportunity to express themselves through multiple mediums.

Students at EIS are committed to creativity, individuality, and growth. These talents are nurtured in order for students to express themselves freely through the arts as well as enabling them to gain important transferable skills. This is in accordance with one of the EIS Learning Principles where students are encouraged to practice meaningfully and intentionally.

Our students can take part in the annual whole-school theatre production. They can contribute through performing, or by being part of the backstage team. Trips, workshops, and performances are organised for drama students to enhance interest and deepen knowledge.

Beyond The Classroom

After School Activities and Extra-curricular Activities

A rich and diverse programme of After-School Activities (ASAs) and Extra-Curricular Activities (ECAs) are provided for all students, from Early Years up to Grade 12. Students can explore their interests in a nurturing space and they can develop their artistic talents, social competencies, physical endurance, and skills. While participating in some of the many activities we offer - including dance, football, and chess - learners have fun in a supervised and supportive environment. ASAs are included in the annual tuition fees.

Field Trips

A range of Field Trips / Learning Outside The Classroom (LOTC) activities are provided to students across all grades. EIS offers an exciting 'Week Without Walls' (WWW), an experiential learning opportunity for students in Grades 3 - 11. LOTC opportunities provide students with time outside the classroom. During this learning period, EIS students are encouraged to go beyond their books and electronic devices and discover the world outside the school walls.

During their time at EIS, students have regular opportunities to apply the knowledge and skills they have acquired in lessons to real-life situations. They are taken out of their familiar routines and comfort zones to broaden their understanding of the external world - an integral component of becoming Global Citizens. A service element is usually included in field trips as it encourages and promotes our school values about caring for others. Students learn to take responsibility for themselves and those around them while becoming independent.

The activities and events during LOTC activities are carefully planned to correspond to the desired outcomes outlined in the IB Learner Profile and the EIS Learning Principles.



Settling into EIS

At EIS, all new students are warmly welcomed throughout the academic year. New starters at the school settle in and make friends quickly due to the supportive, safe, and family-style atmosphere faculty members cultivate on campus. Upon arrival, new students are assigned a "buddy" from their homeroom to assist with orientation and the school timetable.

Along with teachers and the Pastoral Service, the 'buddy' is part of a support system to familiarise students with the school environment. Parent involvement in the school is welcomed via our supportive Class Parent Representatives and Parent Council, and they are invited to communicate easily with Homeroom Teachers and support staff, who will assist with any queries.

The openness of our educational village ensures that all new students and their families feel welcomed and part of our community as soon as they arrive on campus.

Admissions Process

Admission is granted when it has been determined that the School has an appropriate programme and the resources to meet the learning needs of the individual. EIS considers applications for both immediate and future entry throughout the year.

Students will be allocated a year group corresponding to their age at the point of admission. Mirroring the academic year, birth dates for placement into a year group is 1st September to 31st August.
